On January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at approximately 10:30 pm the North Kingstown Police Department received a phone call from a resident of Sauga Ave. in North Kingstown. The resident became suspicious when two younger looking subjects were seen walking from the rear deck area of 2 Sauga Ave. with beer cans in their hands. He called the North Kingstown Police Department to report this information. The North Kingstown Police Party Patrol detail consisting of Detective Jason Clark and Patrol Officer Anthony Favre responded to the home and found several front windows covered with black plastic sheets and pillows. Further investigation found approximately 20 underage juveniles inside the home with a large quantity of beer and liquor present. All of the youths had visible signs of various levels of intoxication. It appeared that all but a few of the youths had the intention of driving away from the party. The vehicles had been parked one block away from the house as to not draw attention to the house.

The host of the party was a 17 year old minor and relative of the home owner who uses the property as a summer home. All of the involved youths are from the Town of East Greenwich. Parental notification was made and each child was released to their respective parents while at the residence. The host of the party was petitioned to the Family Court for possession of alcohol by a person under the age of 18. No other arrests were made.
